## "A serene, sophisticated coastal foundation is balanced



ou'd be forgiven if you've never heard of Muskoka. The pristine, peaceful lakes district in Ontario is one of Canada's best-kept secrets, although enough holiday-makers and celebrities - think, Steven Spielberg and

Tom Hanks – have flocked to its forests, maple farms, craft breweries and storybook cottages, that it's been dubbed 'the Hamptons of the north'.


When interior designer Kate Walker of KWD embarked on the design for a new house on Victoria's Mornington Peninsula, she instantly thought of Muskoka. "I have always been enamoured by North American architecture," she explains. "The Muskoka region of Canada is a breathtaking area that feels familiar and combines two of my loves – the countryside and water. Here from the hinterland there's a beautiful view across Port Phillip Bay that is so reminiscent of Muskoka."

The homeowner was builder and developer Adam Magnus of Magnus Construction. Having previously worked together on about 20 projects, Adam trusted Kate's vision for "a nostalgic sort of aesthetic with punchy interiors," he recalls. "We had a bit of fun with the finishes." Adam and his wife, Jessica, had purchased the already-razed property in 2023, drawn to the block size and proximity to the beach and shops, and with a view to sell it after the build. "The triple-A location warranted luxury," says Adam.

Kate and Adam's frequent collaborator, Heath Blair of Plume Studio, conjured up the landscaping, while Jessica painstakingly sourced furniture, artwork and decor. The finished property, aptly dubbed 'Muskoka', was unveiled 12 months after breaking ground.

Kate peppered the interiors of the four-bedroom home with earthy colours, such as camel and terracotta, integrating shades of blue "that reflect a lakeside rather than the seaside". Bold and hardy materials, such as hardwood joinery, travertine stone and retro wallpaper, marry a cabin sensibility with modern-day elegance.

"You know those movies you watched when you were younger of the North American family going to the lakehouse? That's what we tried to achieve," says Kate.

The primary suite gives main character energy. "The light that filters through is so soft and beautiful, and the space is so private and cocooning," says Kate. "It's a complete departure from the rest of the home, not just by where it's located on the floorplan, but in terms of colouring and tone." In the ensuite, which looks across the garden to the pool, dual Blue Roma quartzite benchtops, a drenching of teal paint and the freestanding bathtub are so transportive, you can almost hear the lakeside holiday sound of children skimming stones.

Were Adam and Jessica ever tempted to keep the house for themselves and their kids rather than sell on completion? "We're tempted to move into a lot of the houses we build!" laughs Adam. "Muskoka is special and has an amazing feel about it ... the natural light, the tones, the spaces. It just wraps itself around you." KWD: katewalkerdesign.com.au.


